



Fire Training Facility & Prop Fee Schedule



These fees are included in training contract proposals or Local Level class costs.

Structural Burn Building Use Costs

4 Hours (Non-Live Fire)	\$150
4 Hours (Live Fire)	\$1000
8 Hours (Non-Live Fire)	\$300
8 Hours (Live Fire)	\$1800

Flammable Gas Fire / Car Fire Props

4 Hours (Live Fire)	\$300
8 Hours (Live Fire)	\$600

Live Fire: includes HACC facilitators, materials, and EMS coverage (if required)

Drill Tower	\$200 = 4 Hours / \$400 = 8 Hours
Smoke Chamber	\$150 = 4 Hours / \$300 = 8 Hours
Roof Simulator	\$ 100 = 4 Hours / \$300 = 8 Hours
Vehicle Training Rescue Pad	\$150 = 4 Hours / \$300 = 8 Hours
Vehicles to cut	\$100 each
Hazardous Materials Training Area	\$150 = 4 Hours / \$300 = 8 Hours
Pump Training Pad	\$125 = 4 hours / \$250 = 8 Hours
Technical Rescue Area (Trench, Collapse & Confined Space Areas)	\$150 = 4 Hours / \$300 8 Hours
Plywood	\$ 25 per sheet
Liquid Smoke	\$ 35 per quart
Dry Chemical Fire Extinguishers	\$ 20 each
Smoke Machine Rental	\$ 30 each
Firefighting Foam	\$ 25 per gallon
Classroom Space	\$100 a day per classroom
